Discussion of the meeting commenced as follows:

BOG 25.0	Welcome to members by the Chairperson, BOG cum Director, NIT Mizoram.
	The Director cum Chairman, Board of Governors, NIT Mizoram while welcoming the members expressed his gratitude for them attending the meeting and to deliberate on a vital agenda item.
BOG 25.1	PROPOSAL FOR APPROVAL OF THE SMILE ERP IMPLEMENTATION IN NIT MIZORAM
	Background:

The Board may be informed that NITMZ/SERVER package amounting to Rs. 30,34,285.72 (estimated) was approved by the 23<sup>rd</sup> BoG held on 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec.2020.

In the 15<sup>th</sup> BoG held on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, under BOG 15.6, the recruitment of two(2) manpower (Software Developer and Deployment Engineer) through outsourcing with the estimated monthly remuneration of Rs. 80,000/- (Rs. 9,60,000/- annually) and this will be booked from the Institute's fund was approved. **Copy at Annexure-1**

i) The first mail was received from NPIU regarding nomination of NIT Mizoram for implementation of ERP through TEQIP on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019 (Copy at **Annexure-A**)

ii) Meeting conducted by NPIU with Single Point Of Contacts (SPOC) of NITs

1st Meeting: 25th May 2019 (at New Delhi)

2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting: 5<sup>th</sup> September 2019 (NPIU office, New Delhi)

3rd Meeting: 29th February 2020 (Kolkata)

iii) Institute received a mail from Chairman, ERP, IIT KGP on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2020 regarding pilot implementation of SMILE ERP at the Institute along with few other NITs. It was mentioned that "NITs need to have suitable hardware infrastructure in place to install and use the SMILE ERP software". (Annexure-B)

iv) Thereafter the system/hardware requirements for the implementation were received on 11th December 2020 (Attached as **Annexure-C**: Tender of IIT KGP). In further correspondence with IIT KGP ERP team, NIT Mizoram also has formulated the specification for the hardwares as per its requirement of 4 servers (**Annexure-D**).

#### Advantage of the SMILE ERP:

- a) There will not be any dependence on private firms for the ERP system of the Institute.
- b) The range of modules fully cater to the requirement of the Institute.
- c) The investment for hardware requirement will be one time.
- d) The total cost of maintenance including manpower will be much less in comparison to the existing system.
- e) For smooth transition from existing system to SMILE ERP, six months to maximum one year parallel run of both the systems is required. This will allow the new manpower to be accustomed to both the softwares. Since source code of existing ERP is already available and source code of SMILE ERP will also be available, the manpower will be in a position to modify both the codes as per the necessity of the Institute. Thereby after completion of the said parallel run period, the existing system along with SMILE ERP can both be used by the Institute.
- In this SMILE ERP regard, NPIU had conducted a meeting with participating NITs in the pilot phase on 18th January 2021 regarding getting stock of the status of implementation at each Institute. The report is attached as Annexure E. In the meeting it was told that Institute has to inform to NPIU about the willingness to proceed further in implementation within 2days otherwise the slot will be allocated to some other NIT.
- On this the ERP committee of the Institute along with Dean (Academics) and TEQIP Coordinator had conducted a meeting on 19th January 2021. The minutes is attached as Annexure-F.
- As per 15<sup>th</sup> BOG (BOG 15.6) held on 19<sup>th</sup> June 2019,

recruitment of 2 manpowers through outsourcing was approved by the board, advertisement for which was given on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2019.

# • Requirement of additional manpower for maintenance of network infrastructure at the Institute

- a) As the Institute is running out of its temporary campus, the various academic blocks are located at different location in and around of Chaltlang area in Aizawl. The layout is attached as **Annexure G**.
- b) The 1Gbps NIC internet link is connected to the servers at Admin Block, which is further distributed from the Admin Block to other blocks.
- c) At times when the network infrastructure fails there is no network person for its maintenance.
- d) Thereby the Institute requires a network professional for its successful maintenance.
- · The details are mentioned as under.

Hence.

- i) The action plan which include Server package amounting to Rs. 3034285.72 (estimated) approved by the 23<sup>rd</sup> BoG held on 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec.2020 may be replaced with the new Server package amounting to Rs. 3800000.00 (exclusive of 18% GST and with 18% GST the amount will be Rs. 4484000.00). Procurement will be done through GeM. This SMILE ERP package will be booked under TEQIP-III.
- ii) For smooth transition from existing system to SMILE ERP, six months to maximum one year parallel run of both the systems is required. The renewal of AMC of the ERP software by M/s MasterSoft ERP Solutions Pvt.Ltd., Nagpur for all the 10 modules for 1 more year, may be approved for the smooth functioning of the Institute, as per revised Terms & Conditions & same rates of contract, on the following considerations;
- a) The successful implementation of SMILE ERP will include data migration on to it, manpower training, and thereafter its flawless use by all stakeholders and subsequent dependence on it by the Institute. This will require 12 months.
- b) Given the pandemic situation the existing ERP system of the Institute is hosted on cloud for easy access of students, faculties and staffs. The academic activities such as students registration, fees collection, mark entry, result processing etc are done through it. Thereby the time frame for its continual use is minimum 1 year after expiry of the existing AMC i.e upto May 2022.
- c) During the AMC period upto May 2022, since both the system will be in parallel use, the manpower will be fully trained on the maintenance aspect of both the system. This will help both the ERP system to be in active use.
- iii) The recruitment of two(2) manpower (Software Developer and Deployment Engineer) through outsourcing with the estimated monthly remuneration of Rs. 80,000/- (Rs. 9,60,000/- annually)is placed for kind note of the Board. This remuneration will be booked under Institute fund.
- iv) Additional manpower (Network Engineer) for maintenance of Institute network infrastructure on contract basis in the level of Technical Assistant on payment of Rs.

40,000.00 /- per month from the Institute Fund is placed for consideration and approval.
After a length of discussion, the Board approved the proposals. However, considering the difficulty in getting technical manpower through outsourcing at Aizawl, it has been decided to engage the required technical manpower, i.e. Software Engineer, Deployment Engineer & Network Engineer, on contract basis.
