	Background: This is to place before the Senate the application dated 27.08.2024 received from Mr. Lalrinsanga, BT21EE005 , a student of Electrical Engineering Course of NIT Mizoram. Copy of the letter is placed at Annexure-I of SNT 27.12 at Page No. 133 – 135. That, the student was admitted to NIT Mizoram during CSAB 2021 and had successfully completed the 1 st & 2 nd Semester. While he was pursuing the 3 rd Semester, his father the sole breadwinner									

	and grandfather passed away leaving the family with financial problem and he had been suffering from mental health issues for which he was under the treatment of a psychiatrist since then. Proof of treatment from Psychiatrist is place at Annexure-II of SNT 27.12 at Page No. 136 - 143
	As he has recovered from the stress now, he feels fit to continue his studies. His maternal uncle has come forward to assist him financially for his continuation/completion of the course. He, therefore, sought the permission of the Institute authority to allow him to join the Institute back and allow him to register in the 2 nd year.
	As per Clause 12.11 of the Curricula of B.Tech Programme, UG students are allowed to complete the 8 Semester Course maximum within 12 Semester i.e 6 years. Since he had been on medical treatment for 2 years after completion of 1 st year, he is left with 3 years for completion of the course which is just enough to complete the 4 years course provided he clear all the subjects in each Semester. Clause 12:11 of the Curricula of B.Tech Programme New (March 2023 onwards) is placed at Annexure- III of SNT 27.12 at page No. 144 for reference.
	The Senate may, therefore, decide if the said student should be given a chance to continue the course and register for the 3^{rd} Semester / 2^{nd} year of the B.Tech programme which he is willing to continue with renewed aspiration.

<i>i. Complete satisfactorily at least minimum 30 credits for B. Tech</i>
<i>i.</i> Complete satisfactorily at least minimum 30 credits for B. Tech Program. AND
ii. Obtain a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of not lower than 4.00 calculated on the basis of some combination of best grades obtained by him/her to attain the minimum 26 credits in B.Tech
Program.
<i>iii.</i> A student failing to complete satisfactorily both the above conditions i.e. 9.5 (i) and (ii), even after going through Re/Special Examinations in first year of admission then he/ she is required to take readmission in next academic session, and repeat the course curricula afresh.
 <i>iv.</i> If a student failing to complete satisfactorily both the above conditions i.e. 9.5 (i) and (ii), even after going through Re/Special Examinations in second year of admission then he/ she is required to discontinue his/her studies after the second year and leave the Institute. <i>v.</i> In no case the total period of completing 1st and 2nd semesters of B. Tech program should exceed two years, else the student shall have to leave the Institute. To determine the total period for completion of 1st and 2nd Semesters of Bachelor's Degree program in two years or for completion of B. Tech. program in Six Years, the period of debarring due to punishment for using unfair means and unfair practice in any examination or due to punishment for disciplinary reasons shall not be counted provided such punishment is for the first time.
On implementation of the above Clause, it is the experience of the Institute that many students of B.Tech Programme who failed to obtain the required CGPA in the 1 st year have to sit back in the 1 st year while many left the Institute to pursue other courses. This being the position, the number of students in the higher Semesters are comparatively lesser than during the admission process of each branch each Academic Year.
At present, there are 10 B.Tech students of 2023-24 Batch who sought re-admission in the 1 st year during the current ODD Semester. Similarly, there are 6 students from 2022-23 Batch and 3 students of 2022-23 Batch who have twice failed the 1 st year and seeking promotion to the 2 nd year. List of the students of the respective Batches is placed at Annexure - I of SNT 27.13 at Page No. 145
Acknowledging the deep frustration of the students who aspire to become engineers, the 69 th Deans' Committee meeting on 28.08.2024 has therefore, recommended omission of <i>Clause 9.5 of the Curricula for B.Tech programme - New (March 2023 onwards)</i> . The meeting

	 suggested that all B.Tech students of 1st year may be allowed for registration in the 2nd year irrespective of the Credits and CGPA secured in the 1st year. Copy of the minutes of the Deans' meeting is placed at Annexure - II of SNT 27.13 at Page No. 146 The proposal is therefore, placed before the Senate – 1. For omission of Clause 9.5 of the Curricula for B.Tech programme-New (March 2023 onwards) with immediate effect and
	for replacement of the said Clause with the following is placed for approval.
	"Clause 9.5: All the students of B.Tech irrespective of the credits and CGPA secured during the 1 st year, except students whose conduct and behaviour in the Institute during the period of 1 st year is undesirable/objectionable for continuation of his/her studies in the Institute, are to be promoted in the 2 nd year.
	2. The Chairman, Senate has approved the provisional registration of the above failed students in the 2^{nd} year B.Tech in line with the above recommendation subject to the approval of the amendment of the said Clause by the Senate.
	The Senate may deliberate on the above proposals at Sl. No. 1 & 2 for approval.
	Decision of the Senate:
	Approved. Clause 9.5 of the Curricula for B.Tech programme- New (March 2023 onwards) shall be revised accordingly.
