Background:

This is to place before the Board that Institute is in receipt of Office Memorandum (OM) vide No. F. 20/42/2021-PPD dated 20.05.2024 from Public Procurement Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India on the subject "Special provisions for Scientific Ministries/ Departments in General Financial Rules

(GFRs), 2017".

Copy of the OM is placed at **Annexure – I of BOG 40.7 Page No. 193 - 196.**

The said OM is issued by the Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India in supersession of the previous Office Memorandum (OMs) issued to carry out amendments in the General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017; and that the special provisions/ amendments laid down in this OM shall be applicable only to 9 (nine) Ministries listed in the said OM of even number dated 20.05.2024.

As mentioned in **Sl. No. (x)** amongst the listed Ministries, National Institute of Technology Mizoram (NIT Mizoram) also being an autonomous Educational & Research Institute, conducting post-graduate/ doctoral level courses or research, under Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, the amendments/ special provisions in the General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017 as highlighted in Office Memorandum (OM) vide No. F. 20/42/2021-PPD dated 20.05.2024 **shall also be implemented and adopted in** *to-to*.

This is to highlight that the amended Rules of GFR 154, 155 are with a raider Note that "These powers can be used for procurement of any items. Further, these powers are to be used only when the requires goods are not available on Government e-Marketplace (GeM) as stipulated in this Department OM No. 6/1/2018-PPD dated 19.01.2018".

The matter is placed before the Board for approval / decision for implementation and adoption.

The Institute may wait for the decision of the Ministry as the matter is under consideration of the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.

BOG 40.8

Amendment in Statutes of NITs and IIEST to prevent overlap in functioning of Director and Chairperson, BOGs.

Background:

This is to place before the Board that Institute is in receipt of Letter vide

F.No. 35 – 2/ 2024-TS.III dated 27.03.2024 from Deputy Secretary (NITs), Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India on the subject "Observations of the President's Secretariat to make suitable amendment in the Statute to prevent overlap between responsibilities of Director and Chairperson, Board of Governors (BoGs)". Copy of the Letter is placed at Annexure – I of BOG 40.8 Page No. 197 – 198.

The same is placed before the Board for initiating uniform amendments in the Statutes of NITs and IIEST as under:

Amendment is Statutes to prevent overlap in functioning of Director and Chairperson

- (I) At present, there are no provisions under the Statutes to extend the term of incumbent Chairperson, BoGs or assign the temporary or additional charge of the post of Chairperson, BoGs of any other NITs of CFTIs in the event of occurrence of any vacancy in the office of Chairperson for any reason. As per the instructions received from the President's Secretariat, we are required to initiate amendment to insert following clause in Statutes 14 of Statutes of NITs and IIEST, Shibpur:
- (v) "In the event of the occurrence of any vacancy in the office of the Chairperson of Board of Governors by reason of expiry of his or her tenure, death, resignation or otherwise or in the event of the Chairperson being unable to discharge his or her functions owing to absence, illness or any other cause, the Chairperson of an Institute of National Importance (INI) nominated by the visitor to fill up the casual vacancy, may discharged the functions assigned to the Chairperson under Section 16 of the Act, for a period of six months or till the nomination of a regular Chairperson, whichever is earlier.

Additionally, in case of expiry of tenure, the Visitor may extend the term of the incumbent Chairperson for a period of six months or till the nomination of a regular Chairperson, whichever is earlier."

(II) As the relevant provisions in the Statutes are being inserted under clause (v) of Statute 14 of the Statutes in order to have clear distinctions between the responsibilities of Director and Chairperson and to prevent any lap of functions provided in the Statutes, it is, therefore, **necessary to delete clause (15) of Statute 17 of the Statutes** of NITs and IIEST-Shibpur, which exist as under:-

"In the event of the occurrence of any vacancy in the office of the Chairperson by reason of his death, resignation, or otherwise or in the event of the Chairperson being unable to discharge his functions owing to absence, illness or any other cause, the Director may discharge the functions assigned to the Chairperson under Section 16 of the Act".

- 2. That, Academic Block-II occupied since 2011 is to be vacated by the month of **September**, **2024** as the building is to be renovated by the Owner. Since Academic Block-II admeasuring 1296 sqm in area and housed the Department of EE & the Department of ECE, **hiring of a new building is imperative for shifting the Departments**.
- 3. With the establishment of 5G Programme for the up-coming semester **an ambient building space of 1000 sqm shall be required** for fresh set-up of **5G Use Case Laboratory**.
- 4. With the overall increase in student strength & laboratories, rooms for faculties of all the Departments have pushed the demand for additional requirement of building space in the Academic realms.
- 5. The increasing number of students strength shall correspond to additional requirement of hostel space for accommodation. Considering the overall necessity towards accommodating the anticipated requirements of space during the AY 2024-25, Expression of Interest was issued on 20.05.2023 on the criteria that offer of Building for Administrative and Academic activities should be within the vicinity of Chaltlang, Aizawl while Hostel buildings should be in and around Durtlang area where majority of the Hostel buildings are located.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE BUILDING RENT ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE

Meeting of the Building Rent Assessment Committee (BRAC) was convened on on 29.04.2024 to discuss matters relating to:

- a) Acquisition of additional building space for the Institute from the building offers received through EOI and
- b) towards the application for enhancement of rent for Buildings hired for Director's Office cum Bungalow and the Research Scholars Hostel.
