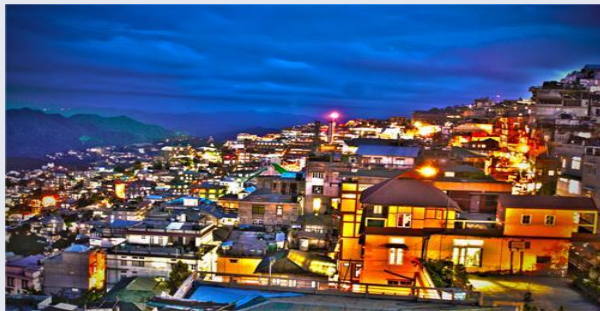


About the Institute
