Instructions to Candidates

1. Candidate will be admitted to the Examination Hall **on production of Admit Card with one copy of recent passport size colour photograph.**
2. The candidate must reach the venue of Competitive Written Examination at **9:00am.**
3. No candidate shall be permitted to leave the Examination Hall until an hour after the question papers have been distributed.
4. Seats should be occupied fifteen minutes before the commencement of the Competitive Written Examination.
5. Candidates should bring their blue ball pens, which will not be supplied by the NIT Mizoram.
6. Candidate should not bring any articles (other than those specified above) such as books, notes, loose sheets, mobile phones, papers, digital diaries, smart gadgets etc.
7. Candidate must write in his/her own hand. Candidates with visual disability who would need the help of a scribe should report themselves to the Establishment Section, NIT Mizoram, two weeks prior to the commencement of the Competitive Written Examination. Answer must not be written in pencil.
8. Candidate must attempt questions in accordance with the directions on each question papers. If the questions are attempted in excess of the prescribed number, only the questions attempted first up to the prescribed number shall be valued and the remaining shall be ignored.
9. Answers, once attempted will be considered as final and no overwriting will be accepted.
10. Candidates detected practicing unfair means or communicating one another or found in possession of unauthorized items as aforesaid in Point No. 6 above during the examination shall be expelled and their names struck off the rolls. They will be debarred from applying for all future Competitive Examinations and selections to be conducted by NIT Mizoram.
12. Candidates must not write or revise their answers after the expiry of the allotted time.
13. Silence must be maintained inside the Examination Hall.
14. The candidates must abide by such instructions, as may be specified on the cover of the answer book/response sheet or further instructions which may be given by the Centre Superintendent of the Competitive Written Examination. If candidate fails to do so, or indulge in disorderly or improper conduct, he/she will render himself/herself liable to expulsion from the Competitive Written Examination and / or such other punishment as the Authority deem fit to impose.
15. Any candidate found to be intoxicated with alcohol/drugs, etc. will be expelled from the Competitive Examination Hall.
16. Mobile phones, if any, brought to the Competitive Written Examination should be kept in the space allotted in the Examination Hall and NIT Mizoram will not be responsible for their safe keeping.
17. COVID-19 Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) – wearing face mask and hand washing shall strictly be followed.

18. Candidates must keep handy atleast one valid **photo bearing identity proof in ORIGINAL** with clear photograph (Eligible photo identity proofs such as 1. Passport, 2. Aadhaar Card/Print out of e-Aadhaar, 3. Driving License, 4. Service ID Card issued to employees by Central Govt./State Govt./ PSUs, 5. ID Card issued by University/College/School 6. Voter's ID Card, 7. PAN Card, 8. Ex-Servicemen Discharge Book issued by Ministry of Defence, 9. Any other Photo Identity Proof issued by Central Govt./ State Govt.).
19. If the Photo Identity Card does not contain the complete Date of Birth, then the candidate must carry an additional original document having the Date of Birth as printed on the Admission Certificate (e.g. Admit Card/ Pass Certificate/ Marks Sheet of 10th Class issued only by CBSE/ ICSE/ State Boards; Birth Certificate, Category Certificate etc. issued only by Central Govt. / State Govt. / PSUs). **In case of a mismatch in the Date of Birth mentioned in the Admission Certificate and Photo ID Proof/ the Certificate brought in support of Date of Birth, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.**

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ANNEXURE- II

OFFICE ATTENDANT: DIRECT RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION

I. MODE OF SELECTION: The Mode of Selection will be as follows:-

- (i) Candidates fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions will be considered **provisionally eligible** and they will be called for the Competitive Written Examination carrying 100 marks.
- (ii) Candidates securing the minimum qualifying marks will be recommended for appointment, **depending on the number of vacant post and in order of merit.**
- (iii) Success in the examination confers no right of appointment unless the Institute is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects of appointment to the service/post.

II. TRADE TEST: Notwithstanding *Clause I (i)* above, a **Trade Test** with

Knowledge of Basic Computer Applications (Word Processing, Spread Sheet etc.)

OR

Driving Test (2 wheeler/Light Vehicle) - under the supervision of MVI,

Carrying 50 marks which is of **qualifying nature** will be conducted. Candidates securing 20 marks and above shall be declared qualified for the Competitive Written Examination.

III. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION: The Competitive Written Examination will consist of **One Objective Type Paper** as shown below:-

INDICATIVE SYLLABUS:

Questions on Numerical Aptitude and General English will be simple, of a level that an average matriculate will be in a position to answer comfortably. Questions on General Awareness will be also of similar standard. Questions on General Intelligence will be non-verbal considering the functions attached to the post.

Part-A: General Aptitude & Reasoning: It would include questions of non-verbal type. The test will include questions on similarities and differences, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, relationship concepts, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

Part-B: General Knowledge: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will include questions relating to National Institute of Technology Mizoram and Mizoram especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene and General Polity. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

Part-C: General English: Candidates' understanding of the Basics of English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure.

IV. RESOLUTION OF TIE CASES: Tie cases will be resolved by applying one after another, as applicable till the tie is resolved, as follows:-

- (i) Candidates securing higher marks in Part-A shall be placed higher.
- (ii) Candidates securing higher marks in Part-C shall be placed higher.
- (iii) Date of Birth, with older candidate placed higher.
- (iv) Alphabetical order in which the names of the candidate appear.

Note:-

1. Pertaining to Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwD), the minimum qualifying marks is relaxable at the discretion of NIT Mizoram, if at any stage of the selection process; the Institute is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from the reserved categories are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancy reserved for them.
