Background: This is to place before the Board of Governors the Status of Forest Clearance of NIT Mizoram Campus at Lengpui, Aizawl, Mizoram and the Status of active Court Cases at NIT Mizoram as under:- I. STATUS OF FOREST CLEARANCE: This is to inform the Board of Governors that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (Forest Conservation Division) (MoEF&CC), Government of India has granted 'Final approval/ Stage- II', vide Letter F.No. 8-02/2022-FC Dated 11th March, 2026, under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, in favour of Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Mizoram for non-forestry use of 63.441 ha Reserved forest land for construction of National Institute of Technology Mizoram in Aizawl District in the State of Mizoram subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:- i. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged; ii-xxiii. Details available in the said letter. The Copy of the letter is placed as Annexure - I of BOG 49.5 at Page No. 39 - 42. In continuation to the above, recently, a copy of letter from the Deputy Conservator of Forest (FC), Office of the PCCF, DoEF&CC, Government of Mizoram to the Director, Higher & Technical Department, Government of Mizoram (User Agency) vide No. B.22013/57/2024-FC/PCCF/175 dated 22.05.2026 has been received, wherein, in pursuance of the Condition 2 (ii) (a) of the Final Approval which states that: "<i>State Government shall ensure that Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised and maintained over already identified non-forest land (NFL) over an area of 64.25 ha and 86 ha Penal Compensatory Afforestation land at the cost of the User Agency</i>", the Office of the PCCF, DoEF&CC, Government of Mizoram has raised a demand on enrichment scheme for 86 Hectares of Penal Compensatory Afforestation area in Aizawl Forest Division for ₹. 13,86,200.00 and 53 Hectares of Penal Compensatory Afforestation area in Darlawn Forest Division for ₹. 14,37,510.00, amounting to a total of ₹. 28,23,710.00 (Rupees Twenty Eight Lakh Twenty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Ten only), which is in addition to the conditions prescribed in the <i>In-Principle Approval</i> accorded earlier, and the said amount has to be deposited in the National CAMPA Account. Background: This is to place before the Board of Governors, the recommendations of the Building and Works Committee in its 18th Meeting vide BWC 18.6 dated 11.05.2026 for revision of Building Rent of Academic Block-IV (Landlord: Mr. Zoramthanga) in the temporary campus located in Chaltlang, Aizawl. Letter has been received from Mr. Zoramthanga, owner of the Academic Block – IV, NIT Mizoram building situated at Chaltlang near the Tourist Lodge Gate, seeking fixation and enhancement of the house rent. In this regard, this is to inform the Board of Governors that at present, the total monthly rent for all the buildings paid by NIT Mizoram for June 2026 is ₹. 89,14,554.00 (including 18% GST). A meeting of the BRAC Committee convened on 13th April 2026 at the Office of the Dean (Planning & Development), NIT Mizoram has duly submitted a report and recommended as under: - a) The said building has been under lease with NIT Mizoram since 01.03.2018 at a rate of ₹. 239.00 per sqm. b) In response to the request submitted by the landlord for enhancement of the building rent from ₹. 239.00 per sqm to ₹. 425.00 per sqm, a detailed comparative analysis has been carried out by the Institute in the vicinity of Chaltlang locality, Aizawl. Upon examination, it has been observed that similarly situated premises are currently being leased at higher rates, indicating an upward trend in rental valuation in the locality and providing a relevant benchmark for consideration of the present proposal. b) The Building Rent Assessment Committee (BRAC) of the Institute, under the chairmanship of the Dean (Planning &

Development), examined in detail the request submitted by the owner of Academic Block - IV for enhancement of the building rent.

The Committee deliberated the matter comprehensively, taking into consideration the premises' current location and the comparative rental rates of other buildings hired by NIT Mizoram in the same locality. It was observed that, while the landlord has requested a substantial rent increase, similar buildings in the vicinity are currently being rented at higher rates.

After due discussion and careful assessment, the Committee recommended a revision of the building rent from ₹. 239.00 per sqm **to ₹. 300.00 per sqm**. Copy of the Letter from the Landlord and the Minutes of Meeting of BRAC dated 13.04.2026 are placed at **Annexure - I of BOG 49.21 at Page No. 279 - 281**.
